INFORMATION

2023, TERM 4 STAFFING UPDATE

This term, we welcome Miss Sanja Koncar who replaces Miss Emily Inness (Room 13). Miss Inness has started her maternity leave and eagerly awaits the birth of her daughter next month.

We also welcome Mrs Erica Houston to our front office team. Erica comes to us from Riverton Primary School.

MOBILE PHONES AT SCHOOL

The Department of Education does not permit student use of mobile phones in public schools unless for medical or teacher-directed educational purposes. As we utilise iPads for educational purposes, our students should not have a mobile phone with them at school.

If a student must bring their phone to school (we understand for some families, students travel to and from school alone, and you provide them with a phone for safety reasons), then it must be turned off and handed into the front office before school, and collected after school.

Phones need to be off and away all day, meaning from entrance to and exit from the school gate.

Our previous process has been that mobile phones were stored in school bags; however, this has caused problems, and following a staff review, **mobile phones will now be kept at the front office**.

Students should only bring a phone to school with parental consent. If we are unsure if parents have provided permission, the admin team will contact parents to confirm.

A reminder to parents that if you need to get a message to your child during the day, you must contact the front office, who will pass the message on.




2024 TEACHERS AND CLASS PLACEMENT PROCESS

TERM 4: EVENTS IN OCTOBER

SCIENCE, READING AND MATHS TESTING (YEAR 1 - 6 STUDENTS)

Our Year 3 to 6 students completed a Science test at the end of Term 3. The Science test is based on the Australian Curriculum content for each year level.

All Year 1 to 6 students will complete a Reading and Maths test in the first fortnight of Term 4. The Reading and Mathematics tests are based on the Australian Curriculum, but are also adaptive, meaning the test moves to easier or harder questions depending on the child's responses. This allows us to better measure progress and identify where each child is at.

These online <u>Progressive Achievement Tests</u> (PAT) are developed by the Australian Council for Educational Research (ACER) and allow us to diagnose student achievement levels, and also measure their individual progress. We also undertook this testing at the same time last year.

These assessments are considered alongside the teacher's judgements, and with other external assessments such as On Entry (P-2), Year 3 and Year 5 NAPLAN, to be sure we know where individual students and cohorts of students are at, so we can plan at the individual, classroom and whole school level.

There is no need for children to be concerned about the tests, and no preparation is required.

FACTION ATHLETICS CARNIVAL (KINDY – YEAR 6 STUDENTS AND FAMILIES)

Our Faction Athletics Carnival, for all students in Kindy to Year 6, will be held over two days. Attached and also on <u>our website</u> is a detailed program for parents.

Day 1 - Monday, 16 October

- 8:35am Kindergarten group A sprints (on oval) followed by tabloid games in the Kindergarten area.
- 8:55am to 2:30pm Jumps, Throws, 200m and 400m events will be held for selected students in Year 1- 6. Students have been selected based on their trial results in physical education lessons. Selected students were provided with a note from Mrs Watkins or Mr Headland at the end of Term 3. The team list is also on the whiteboard outside Block 3 and in the Village Undercover Area. If your child was away at the end of Term 3, this note will be handed out at the beginning of this week.

Day 2 - Friday, 20 October

- 8:30am Pre-Primary to Year 6 faction march to the oval (year 3-6 then return to class).
- 8:40am Kindergarten group B sprints (on oval) followed by tabloid games (Kindy area).
- 8:40am to 11:15am Pre-primary to Year 2 sprints and activity rotations for all students (Year 3-6 students return to class).
- 11:20am to 1:30pm Year 3-6 sprints and activity rotations for all students (Preprimary to Year 2 students return to class).
- 1:30 pm Year 1-6 relays for selected students and presentations (All Pre-primary to Year 6 students to watch).
- Our day will conclude with presentations at 2:20pm.
- The P&C have arranged food vans for parents (not students) to use during the day.
- Students may access the food vans, and also purchase Icy Poles and drinks from 2:30pm.
