Congratulations to Worl faction, who once again, won the outright shield. The final scores were:



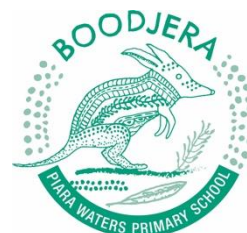

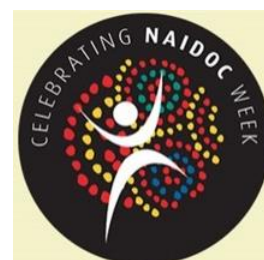
