There were also many activities, such as building animal shelters, creating pipe cleaner caterpillars and identifying leaves found in the playground.

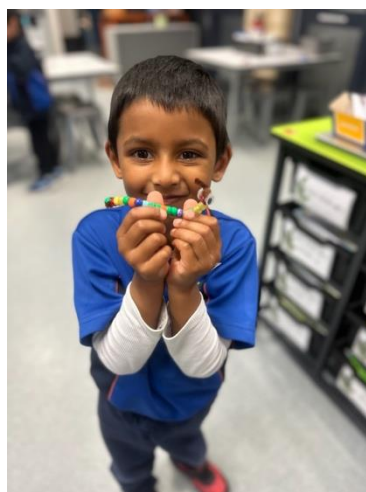
LIBRARY MONITORS

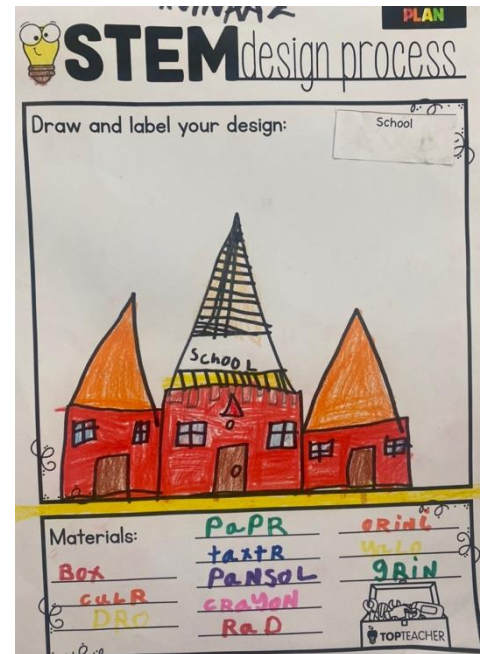
