Families will need to reserve tickets by **the end of today**. Please reserve your tickets **here**.



# **HIGH SCHOOL SIMULATION DAY (YEAR 6)**

Today, our year six students will participate in a "high school simulation day", where they will experience what a day in high school can feel like. The students will be provided with a timetable on Monday morning and participate in their lessons in various rooms around the school.

The core learning the day will target is:

- Reading timetables
- Time management- being prepared, working productively and transitioning in an effective manner.
- Self-management- collecting and managing all resources needed for the day- books, pencil cases, bags, etc...
- Navigating a school map and locating classrooms across a school's campus
- Social skills and manners- adapting to changing classroom teachers and peers for each subject
