#### Maths and Reading high achievers

At the junior assembly, we also presented certificates to the year 1 and 2 students who received the highest ACER Progressive Achievement Tests (PAT) scores.



Congratulations to the following year one and two students who received the "highest" test score in their year level.

Each year, our year one to six students complete the ACER PAT Maths and Reading tests. Our year three to six students also complete the Science test.

This allows us to track the performance of our students in comparison to Australian norms and identify strengths and weaknesses and areas for teachers to focus on. It also allows us to celebrate students who excel in reading, mathematics and science.

### YEAR 6 AND KINDERGARTEN BUDDY ACTIVITY

### 2024 CLASSROOM UPDATE

In 2024, we will receive a new transportable classroom to accommodate our growing number of students. The new transportable classroom (room 54) will be located near Room 10 and will be our Year 4/5 classroom for 2024.

Amongst other things, the addition of the new transportable means changes have been made to the location of some year groups.

In 2024, the following classroom changes will occur:

- The Year 3 classes will move from their current position near the Undercover Area to the Village.
- The Year 6 classrooms will be located next to the Undercover Area.
- The Year 5 classrooms will now be around the Wandjoo play area in Rooms 54, 10, 11 and 20.
- Most of Year 1 will be located in Block 2, with Mrs Rapanaro's Year 1 class staying in Room 9 and Miss Natale's Year 1 class moving to Room 17.

Some families who have been at Piara Waters PS for some time will remember when we had Year 3 in the village and Year 6 next to the UCA.



## A REMINDER ABOUT THE START OF THE SCHOOL DAY

Students should not be on school grounds before 8:00 am if they attend OSH Club, sports training (e.g. running club) or a meeting with their parents. The school has a teacher on duty at 8:00 am. If your child is coming to school independently, we ask that you remind them that they are not to be at school before 8:00 am.

- Before 8:00 am Children must be in the OSH club or attending a sports training activity.
- Between 8:00 am and 8:15 am All K-6 children (and parents) must sit quietly near the flag poles. A teacher is on duty in this area at this time. Walk-to-school raffle tickets will only be provided for children who arrive between 8:00 am and 8:15 am.
- 8:15 am a "double" siren sounds, and students need to move to their classrooms. All classroom doors open at 8:15 am. Students should unpack their bags, hand in home-reading, etc, at this time and prepare for learning.
- 8:30 am learning commences in classes. All students must be in class prior.

The OSH before and after-school care has been fully booked. However, they have advised that they have ongoing vacancies daily, especially when families cancel up to 48 hours prior. You can book <u>HERE</u> for before and after-school care and their school vacation program.
