

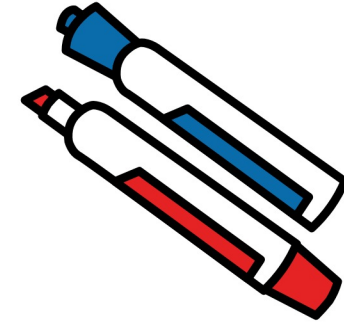
Personal Belongings



Everyone has belongings. These are items that people own.



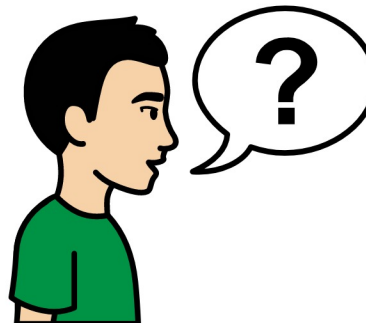
My classmates have belongings that are important to them.



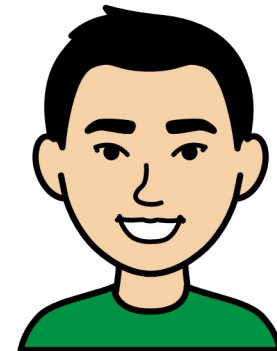
My teachers have belongings that are also important to them.



I also have belongings that are important to me.

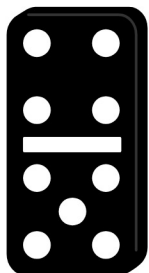


I can ask my classmates at recess and lunch if I want to use their belongings.

Personal Belongings



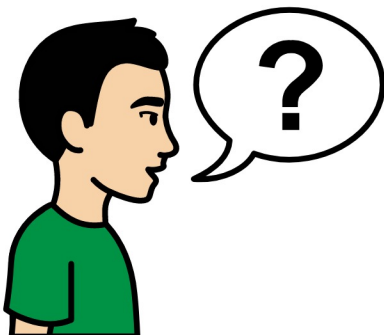
At recess and lunch I can use the equipment in the Games Garden, Oval or Flag Grass Area.



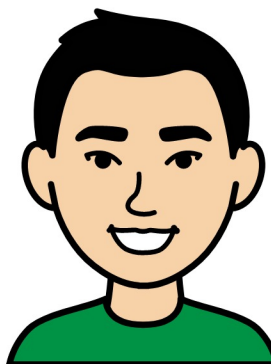
I can choose to share my belongings if I want to.

I can ask my teacher if I want to use their belongings.

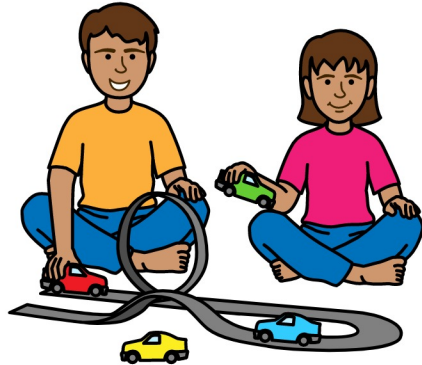


They can say "no", and that is ok too.
