### PREMIER'S READING CHALLENGE



The Premier's Reading challenge runs from Monday, May 8<sup>th</sup> to Friday 8<sup>th</sup> September 2023.

The challenge is for students from Kindergarten to Year 10 to read 12 books or more during this time. Students can win some fantastic prizes.

In addition to this, as a school, we will be running our own competition, where every student who signs up and reads 12 or more books, will go into the draw for our school-based year level prizes (one prize for K,P,1,2,3,4,5 and 6)

### **COVID-19 – CURRENT ADVICE**

We continue to have a very small number of COVID-19 positive cases in our school community.

The most recent advice from the WA Department of Health is;

- If students test positive to COVID-19, to stay home for at least 5 days and until symptoms have resolved to prevent spreading the illness to others.
- To register the positive rapid antigen test (RAT) online with WA Health.
- To tell close contacts of a positive COVID-19 case.

For close contacts without symptoms;

Monitor for symptoms and test for COVID-19 with a RAT before leaving home each day for 5 days.

For close contacts with symptoms:

- For close contacts with symptoms, to test as soon as possible.
- For close contact with symptoms to stay at home for at least 5 days and until symptoms have resolved.

The front office has a very large supply or RATs. Please come and collect as many as you need for your family and friends.
